Reference: Our Letter Ref. #7/4/1/2/1386 dated 28/10/2007

This letter supersedes our referenced letter regarding the above subject.

Effective 30 May 2008 that each certificate holder or approved maintenance organization performing maintenance or preventive maintenance shall ensure each employee applying for initial or renewal of GACA Airman Technician Certificate is trained on the following:

- a. GACA Regulations those associated with the organization functions and as reflected on the certificate and operations specifications.
- b. Organization manuals, policies, procedures, and practices, including quality control processes associated with maintenance, preventive maintenance, inspection, and alteration procedures.
- c. Hazardous Material Awareness.
- d. Maintenance Human Factors.

Recurrent training will be depending upon the complexity of the work tasks, functions, and manpower turnovers. Training maybe as frequent as biannual. It is the responsibility of the man in charge of the organization to ensure that adequate and proper training is given to all maintenance personnel.

Applications before above date will only be accepted on the basis that training will take place prior to the next renewal.
