Requirements for aircraft import and registration (New or old aircraft)

The General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA) has adopted and currently operating under the US Federal Aviation Regulations (FAR) in conducting all aviation issues, owner or his/her legal representative must meet the following: -

- 1. Submit an application signed in ink to the President, GACA.
- 2. An aircraft is eligible for registration, if it is owned or leased by a Saudi Citizen or government unit and is <u>not registered under the law of a foreign country.</u>
- Confirmation of aircraft deregistration from the Civil Aviation Authority of the country in which the aircraft was registered in a form of letter/fax addressed to the Vice President – Safety & Economic Regulation, General Authority of Civil Aviation, P.O. Box 887, Jeddah, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, 21165. Fax +966-2-685-5142, 685-5480 or email address malraddadi@gaca.gov.sa
- 4. Submit GACA-S&ER form 100/B dully filled and signed in ink by the owner or his/her legal representative.
- 5. Fee payment confirmation by GACA Fees & Charges Department.
- 6. Special Requirements of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia must be satisfied in accordance with AC 21-2K. (As revised).
- 7. A letter of delegation to the applicant by the owner.
- 8. Export C of A (if applicable).
- 9. Aircraft bill of sale or any other evidence of ownership (GACA/FAR 47)
- Application (GACA-S&ER 250) for 24-Bit MODE 'S' address for the aircraft must be completed and submitted.
- 11. Aircraft registration mark must be displayed on the aircraft (GACA/FAR 45) after registration.
